

PRAYERS FOLLOWING THE ROSARY

After each decade:

O my Jesus forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those most in need of Thy mercy.

O Sacrament Most Holy, O Sacrament divine;

All Praise and all thanksgiving, Be every moment Thine.

Come Holy Spirit! Come by means of the powerful intercession of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, your well-beloved spouse.

Closing Prayers:

Hail, Holy Queen, Mother of mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope! To Thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve; to thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us, and after this our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.

V/Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God.

R/that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let Us Pray: O God, whose only-begotten Son, by His life, death, and resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal salvation; grant, we beseech Thee, that meditating upon these mysteries of the most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain, and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ our Lord, *Amen*.

August Queen of Heaven! Sovereign Mistress of the Angels, you who from the beginning have received from God the power and mission to crush the head of Satan, we humbly beseech you to send your Holy Legions that under your command and by your power they may pursue the evil spirits, encounter them on every side, resist their bold attacks and drive them far away from us into the abyss of everlasting woe, never to return. In the name of Jesus I ask and, as a child of the living God, I pray.

St. Michael The Archangel defend us in battle; be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. *Amen*.

Please pray one: Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be for Pope Francis.

Chaplet of Divine Mercy

Make the Sign of the Cross

Optional opening prayer:

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world.

O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

(3x) O Blood and Water, which gushed from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of Mercy for us, I trust in YOU!

On rosary beads begin: Our Father, Hail Mary, the Creed

On Our Father beads, pray:

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ,

In atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

On the Hail Mary beads, pray:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion,

Have mercy on us and on the whole world.

In conclusion, pray three times:

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One,

Have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Optional closing prayer:

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.
Jesus, I trust in YOU!



Chaplet of Reparation for Priests

Renewal of the Priesthood by the Holy Spirit

This chaplet of reparation and intercession is meant to be prayed on an ordinary five decade Rosary.

Leader: Incline unto my aid, O God,

All: *O Lord, make haste to help me.*

Leader: Glory Be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit;

All: *As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. AMEN.*

On the Our Father beads:

Leader: Eternal Father, I offer Thee the Precious Blood of Thy Beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lamb without blemish or spot,

All: *In reparation for my sins and for the sins of all Thy priests.*

On the Hail Mary beads:

All: *By Thy precious Blood, O Jesus, purify and sanctify Thy priests.*

End of each decade prayer:

Leader: O Father, from whom all fatherhood in heaven and earth is named,

All: *Have mercy on all Thy priests, and wash them in the Blood of the Lamb.*

Optional conclusion: pray three times the *Glory Be*
